A co-educational 9-12 Catholic high school, Holy Family serves students by preparing them for success in the next phase of their lives. We are accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools and are a full-service high school.

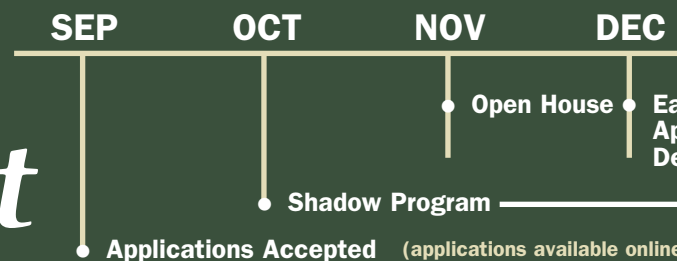
As a Lasallian Catholic high school, we are inspired by the traditions of service to the poor, hospitality to all and embracement of the obligation to serve the larger community. Our pillars of faith, integrity, scholarship and leadership are integrated into all aspects of Holy Family. Convocation is held daily and all-school Mass is celebrated monthly.

Affordable Education

Holy Family's financial aid program is based solely upon a family's financial need and is designed to make Catholic education affordable for all families. Only students who have applied for enrollment are eligible to apply for tuition assistance. Holy Family utilizes the Tuition Aids Data Services (TADS) application to determine financial need. Each application is carefully reviewed to ensure that extenuating circumstances are taken into account before determining eligibility and awards.

Lasallian Scholar Awards are available to any incoming freshman and are based upon the pillars of Holy Family. Students must complete an application and have a non-related adult submit a recommendation in order to be considered for the \$1,500 scholarships.

Exceptional Academics

Holy Family has built a strong reputation for our academic excellence. Students graduate prepared for the next phase in their lives, and have been recognized for their academic accomplishments with numerous post-secondary academic scholarships.

Support Services

Holy Family embraces students with different needs and abilities. Students with IEPs are serviced on campus through the Chaska School District Special Education Department, and students with other learning needs are monitored and serviced through a full-time Learning Specialist on staff at the school.

Take Advantage of the Campus

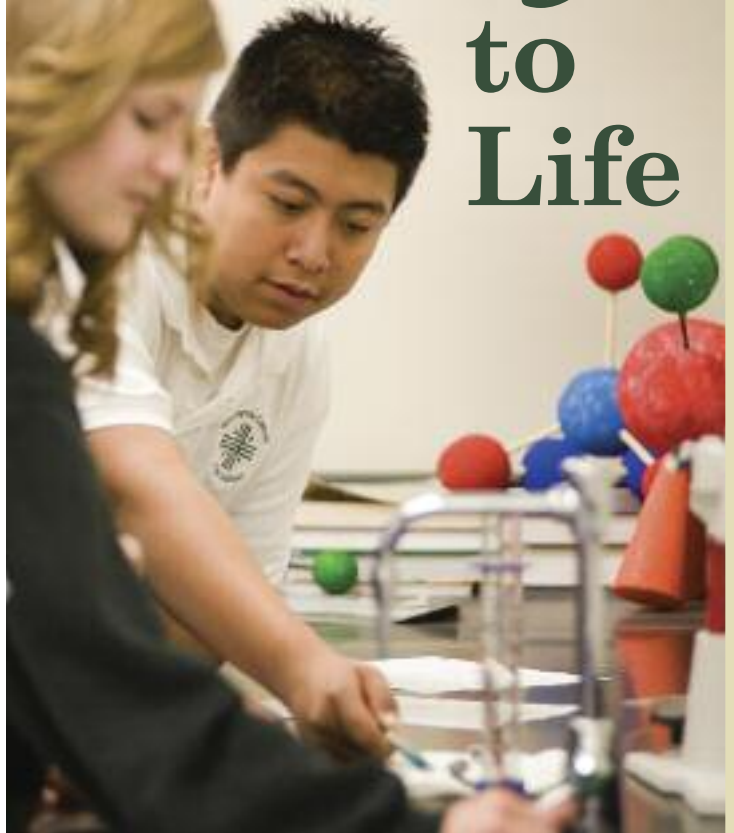
Holy Family is a 165,000 square foot facility with 37 academic classrooms on a seventy-two acre campus located in the southwestern suburb of Victoria. Our campus includes practice and game fields, tennis courts, a cross-country running course and wetlands that are utilized by our science classes for hands-on learning and exploration. Our facility includes a chapel, interactive media center, three computer labs including a Mod Tech Center, music and art suites, gymnasium and a greenhouse/solarium. At capacity, we will accommodate up to 800 students.

The Athletic Arena

Holy Family Catholic High School is a member of the Minnesota River Conference (MRC) along with Mayer Lutheran, Sibley East, Montgomery-Lonsdale, LeSueur-Henderson, Jordan, Norwood-Young America and Belle Plaine. For sports not offered by the MRC, Holy Family has cooperative arrangements with other schools and conferences.

It is our philosophy not to penalize students for being involved in multiple sports and activities but, instead, to encourage student participation in all areas of interest. For many sports we do not cut freshmen, giving them the opportunity to develop their skills or discover new talents.

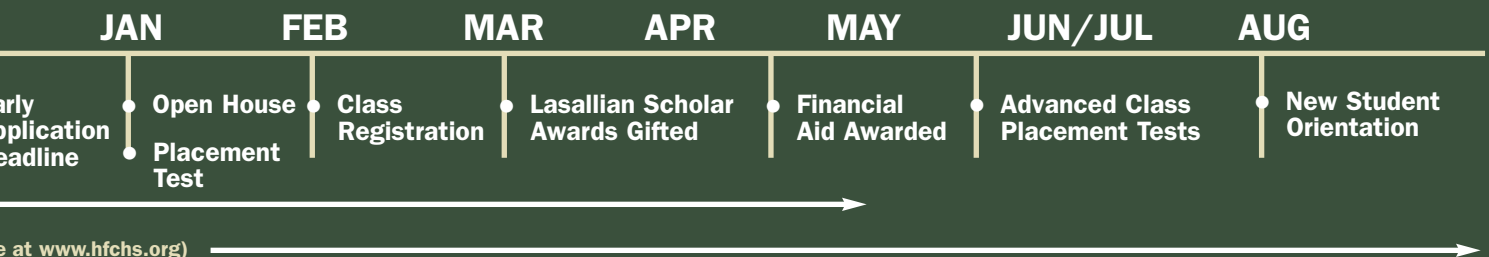

Graduation Requirements

At Holy Family Catholic High School, a student will be awarded a diploma upon earning 25 credits, of which 21 are required: Theology (4), English (4), Speech (.5), Social Studies (3), Science (3), Mathematics (3), Health (.5), Physical Education (1), Technology (1), and Fine Arts (1).

At least two or more credits of a world language is highly recommended. Holy Family offers seven levels of Spanish, five levels of French, and four levels of Italian and Latin.
