1. What to wear?

Closed toed shoes, dress in layers, be comfortable, no skirts, minimal accessories

3. Checkin-9:00-9:15 pm in the Multipurpose Room

The parents managing check in will confirm that you have turned in your permission slip and that you have turned over all personal items to your parents. Once you have checked in, you will be asked to stay in the multipurpose room, so make sure you've used the restroom and said your goodbyes. The more organized we are in the check in process the quicker we are on our way.
4. We will assign you to buses and whatever bus you get on for departure from Holy Family, either Bus 1 or Bus 2, you must ride that bus for the entire night. Please do not give chaperones a difficult time and ask to switch once you are on a bus.
