

Holy Family is pleased to introduce the implementation of an on-line payment service called ***e-Funds for Schools***. This optional, user-friendly service offers various options for parents/guardians who ***choose*** to make on-line payments for lunch and other purchases via a secure website.

- **How does *e-Funds for Schools* work?**
- *e-Funds for Schools* will help to eliminate last minute check writing hassles, improve efficiencies, and help cut costs for both you and Holy Family.
- Parents/Guardians set up and maintain their own logins, passwords, and payment preferences. Your account information is retained in a password-protected file.
- Payments from a debit card, credit card or checking account may easily be set up.
 - A transaction convenience fee of \$1.99 applies to all debit or credit card payments.
 - A transaction convenience fee of \$1.00 applies to all payments made from checking account.
 - There will be a Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) charge if the payment is "bad".
- Parents/Guardians may establish a reoccurring payment or may opt to make a one-time payment.
- On-line payments will help eliminate the worry that your child/children could lose or forget their lunch money.
- Your payment history for the year is available with a click of the mouse.

Note: You will continue to use the "Lunch Account Information" link on the school website to see your child's cafeteria purchases and to view their lunch account balance.

What methods of payment are available to parents/guardians for the 2009-2010 school year?

1. You can use the *e-Funds for Schools* website any time of day or night to make a payment from your checking account or by using a debit/credit card.
2. As in the past, you can still write a check directly to the school.
